**Directions:**

Please use the 'top gate' to enter – the gate has a small white sign saying 'Menneheim; Odendaal'. GPS Coordinates for farm entrance: 29°08'16.1"S 30°35'30.2"E (hopefully correct!)

*From Pietermaritzburg* – approx. 1 hour (2 hours from Durban)  
Take the R33 from PMB. Approx. 6km after the Seven Oaks service station you will cross the (small) Mvoti river, then turn left onto a dirt road signed 'Shalom Ministries'. (If you pass the grain silos you have driven too far). Menneheim farm is approx. 2km along the dirt road, on the right.

*From Johannesburg* – approx. 6 hours. Take the N3, before Mooi River take Exit 146 'Mooi River (North)'; turn left after going through the small toll gate, then turn right onto the R103, drive through Mooi River, then left onto the R622 to Greytown.

*From Greytown* – approx. 15 min. Take the R33 towards PMB, after the Grain silos on the left, look for a right turn onto a dirt road, signed 'Rietvlei'. Menneheim farm is approx. 2km along the dirt road, on the right.
