

Heffalump cabin

Heffalump cabin nestled in Bushwillow Grove, which is situated a stone's throw from the Maretlwane River, is ideal for a couples retreat. The closed riparian woodland makes for excellent birding habitat and specials such as Half-collared Kingfisher, Violet-backed starling, Greater honeyguide, Jameson's Firefinch and little Sparrowhawk are regularly sighted. This part of the farm is also a favourite place for Nyala that can often be viewed from Heffalump's wooden deck in the early morning.

Heffalump has one bedroom with a double bed and an en suite bathroom that has both a shower and a bath. There is an open plan lounge and kitchen with a dining table. The kitchen is equipped with cutlery and crockery, gas stove and fridge. Bedding and towels are provided.

A braai drum is provided outside and wood can be bought at R50 per load.
